Notes for John Peder Christian Johnson:

FAGM #145998673 -- He and brother were left as orphans at an early age but were raised by the Michelson (or Michaelson) family in Denmark, which was the name he went by until coming to America. He used the name Jensen when arriving in America. The brother died at an early age. John arrived in America in 1856 through New Orleans, came up the Mississippi to St. Louis, and then on to Chicago . He bought and farmed 40 acres in the Chicago area. He and family moved from Chicago, Illinois to Gilmore, Illinois in 1862 and bought and farmed 80 acres. When getting the deed for the farm in Effingham County, he was told that his last name would be recorded as Johnson (not Jensen). John was a Captain in Denmark and fought in the war between Denmark and England at St. Thomas Island. The 1870 Census shows the last name as "Johnston" and lists Andrew Pearson (known to be Sena's future husband Andrew Peterson, age 20, born in Demark and a friend of the Johnson family while living in Denmark), as member of the household. The value of real estate listed in the 1870 Census owned by Johnson was \$1600; the value of personal items was \$655. It is uncertain where he was buried in the Gilmore, IL area as there is no known grave marker.

Notes for Andes Andrea Marie (Mary) Andersen:

FAGM #145998846 -- Moved from Chicago, Illinois to Gilmore, Illinois in 1862 with husband, son, and daughter. The 1870 Census shows her name as "Mary."

Notes for Soren Johnson:

Two FAGM #: FAGM #146000651 -- According to the 1920 US Census, Soren immigrated to America in 1857 (age 9) and was a tool dresser (blacksmith) for the Pennsylvania railroad in Terre Haute, IN. According to the obituary for daughter Lutie Mae (Johnson) Conover, Soren moved his wife and family to Terre Haute, IN, in 1898. From the Chicago Tribune, March 15, 1932 - "Soren Johnson, Father of Motor Manufacturers, Dies" -- Soren Johnson, 88 years old, 813 Hickory Street, Waukegan, died yesterday in the Victory Memorial Hospital there after an illness of a month. Mr. Johnson, formerly a resident of Terre Haute, IN, moved to Waukegan two years ago. His four sons own the Johnson Motor Company of Waukegan, makers of outboard motor boats. He is also survived by his widow and a daughter. Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at Terre Haute. [From this information, Soren was born 1844 and lived in Terre Haute, IN, until 1930.] From the 1910 U.S. Census - Soren lived in Terre Haute, Ward 5, Vigo County, IN. He was born in Denmark and immigrated to the U.S. in 1855. He was married to Bertha (Bessie) who was 10 years younger (born 1854). In the household, living with Soren and Bertha was son Louis (age 27, born 1883), son Harry (age 25, born 1885), son Julius (age 23, born 1887), daughter Lutie (age 18, born 1892), and son Clarence (age 14, born 1896). From the 1920 U.S. Census - Soren and Bertha (Bessie) were living alone in there house at 717 N 10th Street. Terre Haute, Ward 5, Vigo County, IN. His occupation was Tool Dresser for the PA railroad. The immigration and birth years were slightly different than reported in 1910. From the 1930 U.S. Census - Soren and Bertha still lived at their home in Terre Haute, IN, which they owned and was valued at \$3,000. Soren identified that he was 30 years old when married, and never attended school although he could read and write in both English and Danish. From the Terre Haute Tribune, Sunday, February 21, 1960 - "Local Resident Remembers the Johnson Family" by Dorothy J. Clark - Mr. Fred J. Hauer, who lives at 713 North Tenth Street, has many memories of his former neighbors, the now-famous Johnson brothers, who are world-renown for

their Seahorse outboard motors manufactured at Waukegan, IL. At the time Mr. Hauer first knew this hard-working family, just after the turn of the century, it consisted of the father. Soren Johnson, his wife, Bessie, and their six children, Arthur, Louis, Harry, Julius, Lutie, and Clarence, who was about Mr. Hauer's age. Soren Johnson, of Swedish extraction, was considered one of the finest tool-dressers, a positive genius in tempering dies and cutting tools. He had come to Terre Haute from Effingham, IL, to work as a blacksmith in the Pennsylvania Railroad shops located then just east of the Union Depot. The family located first on North Eleventh street, later moving west across the alley to 717 North Tenth Street. In the rear of this property was an old barn, where the mechanically-minded sons fixed up a machine shop in the loft. Julius Johnson operated a lathe powered by a five-horsepower gasoline engine called a "Yellow Jacket." Here he and his brothers built their first 2.5-horsepower motor boat engines. With some other boating enthusiasts they formed the Terre Haute Motor Boat Club with headquarters at Bert Shewmaker's wharf, located on the Wabash River at the south side of the Pennsylvania Railroad bridge. Progressed to Bigger Engines: As they learned more about gasoline engines and boats they started building more powerful engines for larger boats. The ``Ark'' was a John boat, a flatbottomed, square-ended scow. The ``Arrow'' was a faster boat and the well-known ``Black Demon' was even faster, equipped with two 12-cylinder engines. Mr. Hauer remembers watching the speed tests of the ``Black Demon.'' Julius Johnson would sit on a piling across the river and clock the boat's speed as it came down the river from the second sand bar. The 'Black Demon's' time of nearly a mile a minute was considered sensational in those days. Over the years many have moved away, but some of the old neighbors still live nearby. There were the Clines, the Brown, the Sheehans, the Mullins, and the Steidels. According to Mr. Hauer it was a regular United Nations settlement with all nationalities and religions. Many good times were had by these families. When someone wanted to put in a well he'd make it known around the neighborhood that there would be plenty to eat and drink and the job would be finished in one day. A fence would be put up with the same neighborly cooperation. Many times the families would all go up to Fort Harrison together for picnics and basket dinners. One event that they enjoyed which was new to me was an ox-tail party. Juvenile delinguency was unknown in that neighborhood in those days. The boys were fascinated by the Johnson brothers and their tiny shanty in the furnished heat in bitter weather and an old hand drill-press and vise made by old Mr. Johnson was a grand place to sharpen ice skates. Skating on the Wabash: The boys skated on the Wabash River between the Vandalia and the Big Four bridges until ice-cutting time came around. The sight of the men coming with saws and mule teams to cut and haul the river ice away to be stored in straw was a sad one indeed to iceskaters. Another favorite place to skate was Conover's Pond where the ice was good all winter sometimes through the month of March. On moonlight nights the gang would sometimes skate until 11 o'clock and then separate to climb in through bedroom windows to escape parental displeasure. Mr. Haure remarked that although the Johnson boys ``catered´´ to water much of the time, none of them could swim. One very dark night when the river was bank full, Hauer went with his friends up to Jensen's camp in their boat, the ``Arrow.'' When the boat struck a floating tree, luckily there was no damage, but a thoroughly frightened boy and his friend, Lawrence Ruby, walked all the way home rather than risk the dangerous river route again. It was in the old barn back of 717 North Tenth Street that the Johnson brothers built their first airplane motor. Their first complete airplane was a bi-plane constructed of white pine, hand-carved, glued and fitted together. Even the propeller was handcarved. When this first airship failed to prove up to their expectations, young Hauer was shocked to see them take an axe and chop it to bits. Their next airplane was a monoplane which resembled a big horsefly and had an all-aluminum fuselage. The same engine was used in this plane equipped with double valves invented by the Johnsons. A model of this plane has been donated to the National Air Museum in Washington, DC, by the Johnson brothers. On August 8, 1911, Louis Johnson flew this plane for the first time at an "aviation field" on the Elroy Smith farm near Ellsworth. With his brothers Harry and Julius, months of work had been put in on this new venture. Shortly after 5 AM after speeding along the ground for a distance of about 100 feet, the "flyer" rose gracefully and then the trip around the field began. Louis kept the machine close to the earth on this first flight, only four feet above the ground. After making some adjustments the second flight was begun about 10 AM and was even more successful than the first attempt. This time Louis allowed the machine to soar 40 feet in the air for a distance of about 300 yards. The speed was estimated at about 30 miles per hour. Carl Stahl assisted the

brothers. When Mrs. Johnson heard the new she said: ``I am glad the machine is a success for the boys have done some fine work on it. I am not much afraid about them going up but I always worry some when they start to come down. I think that is the most dangerous part of flying. They will all have to learn flying just like they had to learn walking." Mr. Hauer has some of the hand-made tools of old Mr. Johnson; his blacksmith tongs, wrenches, etc., which show the real advancement over the years in tool design. Mr. Johnson rode a tandem bicycle similar to a tricycle which was motor driven and had a toolbox mounted on the side for frequent repairs. In his late seventies he would still ride this contraption back and forth to West Terre Haute. The home workshop was soon outgrown and the Johnson brothers moved their place of business and invention to the south end. When it became apparent that the necessary capital was not to be raised here in this own hometown, the Johnson brothers moved their growing business to Waukegan. After the invention of the Seahorse outboard motor, their success was assured, and the loss of such a large enterprise to this community still puzzles local residents. After living on North Tenth Street for some 27 years, the parents followed their sons to Waukegan sometime before 1932, as near as Mr. Hauer can remember. The next time you visit our nation's capitol, be sure and visit the museum and see this beautiful piece of craftsmanship, a model of Johnson's first airplane, which was invented, constructed and flown here in 1911.

From the Star Press (Muncie, Delaware County, IN), 11/11/1913 (p.3, col 4&5) - "Word was received that Arthur Johnson of this city, was scalded to death in Chicago. He was one of the Johnson brothers, who build motor boat engines and aeroplanes, but had lived in Chicago recently.

iii. LOUIS J. JOHNSON (son of Soren Johnson and Bertha (Bessie) L. Lawson) was born on 16 Oct 1881 in Effingham County, IL. He died on 06 May 1963 in Coral Gables, Dade County, FL. Notes for Louis J. Johnson:

Had 1 daughter according to a note from neice Dora (Peterson) Martin. According to an undated and unknown newpaper article, Lou designed and constructed and in 1911 flew the first successful American monoplane in Terre Haute. After this time, the three brothers (Lou, Clarence, and Harry) concentrated on a two-cycle gasoline engine which could be attached to the rear wheel of a bicycle. The recession of 1921 forced the brothers' Johnson Motor Wheel Company into receivership. That same year brought the development of the twocylinder motor. Outboard motor history was made on November 6, 1952, when the millionth outboard motor manufactured by Johnson Motors of Waukegan rolled off the assembly line. Johnson Brothers From the Terre Haute Tribune-Star, Sunday, February 28, 1971 - "Pioneer Flying Days of Johnson Brothers in City are Recalled" by Niki Lee Mahoney - Many cities have their historical "firsts" that the citizens brag about. Terre Haute had a notable one in aviation that was not recognized as noteworthy at the time. An Argosy magazine article of September 1961, calls it "The Great Indiana Airplane Blunder." Louis, Harry, Julius and Clarence Johnson of Terre Haute, the Johnson's of Johnson Outboard Motors fame, built and flew in 1911 what Argosy calls a plane 25 years ahead of its time the first all-metal monoplane ever built in the U.S. that would really fly. "The young brothers were isolated in the backwoods of the Middle West, and if there had been a conspiracy, events and time could not have been more brutally against them, "the Argosy article says. The Johnson brothers could not get much financial support from the businessmen of Terre Haute, and a tornado on Easter Sunday night, March 23, 1913, flattened their plant on the banks of the Wabash, after which the brothers were forced to abandon their plane for more financially lucrative marine motors. Maurice H. Burke, a retired history teacher at Honey Creek High School, has two brothers, John R. and Edward F. Burke, who recently visited Julius Johnson at his home in Bradenton, FL, and Johnson reflected on his early days in aviation. John and Edward, who were from Terre Haute originally and live in Bradenton in the winter, were among a group of curious kids who watched the brothers learning to fly their metal plane in 1911 and 1912 in the field bordered by old 7th Street Road on the west, Stop 1 or Davis Avenue on the south, Margaret Avenue on the north and the old E&I Railroad on the east. The first all-wood plane was built by the Johnsons in 1904 or 1905 when they lived at 717 North 10th Street, Julius relates. They later lived at 1600 Hulman Street. When it was finished in July 1910, they took it to a field about three miles east of Blackhawk. However, the wood plane was tail heavy. Harry, the designer, and Julius, the mechanic, were discouraged, but Louis, the oldest brother, convinced them to use the wood plane as a prototype to build one of aluminum and nickelsteel plate. They started this plane in the fall of 1910. Julius said that one of their experiments was from a tri-pod with a line from the top. They rotated different wing sections around a circle on a 20-foot radius with a rope to determine the proper wing contour or curvature and resistance to get the most lift. Engines were Easy: The engine was relatively easy for the Johnsons because of their experience with marine engines, but they had to make their own spark plugs because regular ones were shorted out by the heat of the two-cylinder engine. Then, on August 8, 1911, the plane was ready to fly, and they took it to the field where John and Edward Burke, reporters from the newspapers and other curious onlookers watched them. Lou flew the 60-horsepower plane which had a tricycle landing gear closely resembling the landing gear of today's planes. It even had a brake to slow the plane after landing, something the Liberty planes and early mail planes did not have. The first flight was at an altitude of about four feet for one hundred feet. The second flight, a few hours later, was at an altitude of 40 feet and the distance was about 300 yards. They estimated the speed at 30 miles per hour. After the first successful flights, the four brothers used their plane for fun and profit, although the profit was not sufficient to build more planes. These early flying adventures were not without their risks, Julius relates. Louis was flying over

South 17th Street once when the motor konked out. He turned the plane around and glided back to the field at 7th Street and Margaret Avenue. He landed in the field where the coke plant is today, but the plane was damaged when the wing strut struck a boulder in the field. But they were ready to fly again in a short while. The article in Argosy says, "Lou Johnson flew his plane over Indiana and Illinois for five glorious years. Trains stopped when he raced them, doing sixty miles per hour, so the people could poke their heads out of the windows or jump out for a moment to see." The magazine describes the pilot as "conquering the sky and the world." Although they did get a small loan from the president of the Terre Haute First National Bank, nobody else of any importance took much notice of the brothers' accomplishment. "The schrewdest Indiana businessmen admired it, but shrugged when the Johnsons asked them to invest in a factory to build similar planes. As far as they were concerned, the plane had no commercial value." In 1913, according to the obituary of Harry, who died in November of 1967 at age 83, the Johnson airplane motor ran continuously for 10 hours. This feat won the brothers a bid for a contract with the Russian Czarist government for fighter plane engines. The Russians persuaded them to try to develop a 12-cyclinder engine, so they built first a six- then an eight- and finally a 12-cylinder engine. However, the Russians did not give them a contract, and the brothers had gone into debt after building a factory on the Wabash for the larger engine. Just as they set up production for their own magnetos, the Easter tornado of 1913 flattened their plant. To make it worse, the flooded Wabash swallowed anything that was left the next day. Right after the tornado, they left Terre Haute for South Bend and ended their plane building, although they still flew it at times for two more years. They had families which needed to be supported, so they produced motors for bicycles, which were put out of business by the Model T Ford. In 1927 the Johnsons moved their outboard motor factory to Waukegan, IL, where they built the famous motors. Now Johnson is a division of Outboard Marine, Inc. Both Louis and Harry died in the late 1960s, but Julius still lives in Bradenton, FL, and Clarence in Rivera Beach, FL. Harry's daughter, Frances Johnson, lives in Valparaiso, IN. "If the world had noticed them at the time, their name, Johnson would have been emblazoned in aviation history next to Bleriot and Wright and Curtis and Martin," the Argosy article states. The blunder it speaks of was that of the state of Indiana and Terre Haute in not backing the brothers. A scale model of the plane is on display at the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, DC. It was built by the brothers after two years of work, between 1957 and 1959, at Harry's home in Culver, IN. The Argosy article said of the museum curator who asked them to construct the model, "Casually, without real knowledge of the discovery he was about to make, (Paul) Garber not only released the Johnsons from their tight-lipped silence (they seldom talked about their accomplishment except to close relatives) but gave America a rare example of its own special brand of There was no patterns or specifications left of their airplane, but the brothers set out to complete the task of remembering the dimensions. The wingspread, they remembered, was 36 feet and the fuselage was more than 30 feet. They had some old snapshots and newspaper clippings, but the wings were from the ground by finding out how tall their brother-in-law, Warren Conover, was with a top hat on. He was standing right under one of the wings in a snapshot. They did finally get all the measurements and Harry had them down on paper. Julius whittled out a wood pattern whenever they had a measurement that was precise. The head curator of the Smithsonian, Paul Garber, said to Harry Johnson, when he presented the plane, "Your plane could only have evolved from genius." Garber commented on the "ingenious details in the construction," the fuselage, the radiator which was more efficient than Curtis and Wright's, and the brake. "My God, man, what an accomplishment!" Garber said. The author of the Argosy magazine article asked, "Who knows how far the course of aviation would have gone by now if only someone had followed the lead of the Johnson boys, who designed a fabulous, streamlined airplane 25 years too soon.

FAGM #100497858, with tombstone picture -- In 1862 Sena moved, with her parents, from Chicago, Illinois to Effingham Count y, West Township, Gilmore, Illinois. Her tombstone incorrectly identifies her first name as "Sane" instead of "Sena." On the Illinois Statewide Marriage Index, Sena is identified as Adnes S. Johnson and Andrew is identified as Anders Peterson. From handwritten notes made by daughter Dora (Peterson) Trapp-Martin: Sena Andrea Marie Johnson was born in Chicago, Illinois on June 4, 1858, and died in Gilmore, Illinois on August 4, 1939; she married Andrew on May 13, 1872, in Effingham, Illinois. In 1932, at their 60th wedding anniversary, Andrew and Sena were the oldest living married couple in Effingham County, and one witness from the wedding, Louis Assmuson of Chicago, was present at the 60th anniversary celebration. Both Andrew and Sena are buried in the Mahon Cemetery, up the hill about 100 yards. Sena was the daughter of John Christian Johnson and Marie Andrea (Anderson) Johnson of Chicago, Illinois. Her mother was born in Blokhus, Denmark. Her father, John Christian Johnson was born in or near Blokhus, Denmark, and he and a brother were left as orphans at an early age. The brother died. John was either adopted or raised by a family named Michelsen by which name he was known by until he came to America. Before coming to America, John served as a captain in the war between Denmark and England, on St. Thomas Island. John then came to America with his wife Marie Anderson and 9-year old son Soren in 1856. They arrived in New Orleans and traveled up the Mississippi River to St. Louis and then on to Chicago, "which was just a little village at that time.". In Chicago, John bought 40 acres and farmed it. In 1862, John, Marie, Soren, and Sena moved to Effingham County, West Township, where they bought 80 acres and farmed it. Also, according to Dora, "grandpa's real name was Jensen, pronounced with a "Y," and was changed to Johnson when he came to Effingham to record the deed for the farm--and that is that ".). John died 10 years later in late

July/early August of 1872 and Marie died in late January/early February 1873. Sena's brother Soren married Bertha (Bessie) Lawson in Effingham, Illinois, in 1874, and had seven children: Hattie who married Frank Hardin and had one son named Bert; Arthur who died young; Louis who married and had one daughter; Harry who married and had one daughter; Julius who married and had three children; Clarence who married and had one son; and Lutie who married Warren Conner and had a son and a daughter. Harry and Julius and possibly Clarence -- with financial help from Louis -- formed Johnson Brothers Outdoor Motors Company of Terre Haute, Indiana, and built and flew the first American monoplane during 1911-1913 and gave the monoplane to the Smithsonian Institution in Air and Space Museum in 1959 for display. The Andrew Peterson family attended Asbury Church in Gilmore, Illinois. Dora said ``Asbury Church was just a plain building with two steps to enter. Inside, a chimney was built in the center of the church with a pot-bellied stove kept hot. If you got too close, you would get scorched clothes. The pulpit had a tall desk within where the Bible was kept, and all records were kept in the Bible. When a new generation took over, they got a new Bible. The old one was given to Norman Millington, to care for it. When Norm died, his wife Lou gave it to mother -- Mrs. A. Peterson. After she had it some time, she turned it over to Sylvester Spragg. At that time he was living with his daughter, Sude Pfister. When their house burned, the Bible burned too. So, the records were lost too. When the next generation came, they made modern improvements. They had no musical instruments until about 1913 or 1914, when they purchased an organ. I don't remember who was the first to play it since I was not there. We used to have ice cream sales to make money to pay for our improvements. The church had a creek, west and south, with trees and shrubbery. Also, on the east was a hitching post. At most meetings, they were all occupied with horses hitched to all kinds of vehicles: farm wagons, spring wagons, buggies, carts, and horseback horses. A few names of charter members: Dave Shoemaker, William and Tom Hollis, Spragg, Stiffler, Murphy, Johnson, Peterson. Matt Hooks didn't come until 1885. I think I'd better sign off, wishing you all a joyful day, Dora." From handwritten notes made by granddaughter Andrea (Siddens) Calhoun: Sena Andrea Marie (Johnson) Peterson Dies: Sena Andrea Marie Johnson was born in Chicago, Illinois, June 4, 1858, and departed this life August 4, 1939, aged 81 years and 2 months. She was the daughter of Peter Johnson and Andes Andrea Marie Anderson. At the age of 4 years she, with her parents, came to Effingham County, West township, where she had resided ever since. On October 13, 1872, she was united in marriage to Andrew Peterson. To this union were born eleven children, four dying in infancy, and George at the age of 13 and Anna at the age of 35. She leaves to mourn her loss five children, namely: John C. Peterson, Windsor, Illinois; Dora Martin, Lincoln, Illinois; Sophia Ohlson, Chicago; Lillian Siddens, West township, and Henry at home. Two grandsons, Harry Ohlson and Raymond Martin, and three granddaughters, Andrea, Vera, and Oma Siddens, and one great granddaughter, Florence Ohlson, nieces and nephews and numerous friends and neighbors also mourn her passing. ``Dear mother, thou hast left us, thy sufferings are now o'er; In heaven you are rejoicing with the dear ones gone before. At the dear old home no longer can we gather, as of old, For our family tie is broken; she has found the heavenly fold. We have lost our darling mother; she has bid us all adieu; She has gone to live in heaven and her person is lost to view. We stand before your casket, smooth back your lovely hair, Upon your marble forehead, we leave the last kiss there. Your busy hands are resting, your work on earth is done; Your trials all are ended, your heavenly crown is won. Tomorrow will bring back sad memories of one we lay to rest, But the ones who think of you today are the ones who love you best. You have gone away dear mother to your Savior good and true. You have won the heavenly glory which for your children is yet to do." Ultimately, the tombstone for Andrew is spelled Peterson. According to a newspaper clipping regarding Andrew's and Dora's trip back to Denmark in 1913. "...[i]ust forty-four years ago Mr. Peterson left [Denmark] and came to this country. He sailed from Copenhagen on Octo 1st and landed in Quebec, Canada, two weeks later. From there he went direct to Chicago and then down on the Illinois Central to Effingham. From here he went to Gilmore and joined the Danish settlement at that place. Mr. Peterson is the last of that settlement in the Gilmore neighborhood." From handwritten notes made by Dora (Peterson) Trapp/Martin, daughter, Andrew came to America through New York, then went to Michigan where he worked at various jobs until 1871. In 1871 he came to Effingham county, settling in West Township with the Johnson family, whom he knew from his early days in Denmark, and later married Sena Johnson who was 10 years younger. He lived there and farmed until his death. At some point, "Pedersen" was changed to "Peterson" while in America. According to a handwritten note of daughter Dora Martin, ``it was the custom in those days that a man's [sons] took the name of their father's first name. Hence, Peder (or Peter in America) Andersen's sons were named Pedersen." In handwritten notes, Dora Martin identified that Andrew was one of six sons and two daughters. However, in Dora Martin's diary and accompanying pictures, Dora refers to Uncle Andersen as "dad's brother' but she did not list him as one of the actual brothers. From the Effingham Record-Democrat Newspaper -- In October 1913, Andrew and eldest daughter Dora began a journey back to Denmark to be with Andrew's family following his mother's death in August 1913. The local newspaper published a series of articles about the adventure. The first is as follows: Taking European Trip: A. Peterson and his Daughter, Mrs. Dora Trapp, Going to Denmark -- "The first of this week A. Peterson, of Gilmore, and his daughter, Mrs. Dora Trapp of this city left on a trip to Europe where they will spend the winter on a visit to Mr. Peterson's old home in Denmark (spelled ``Danmark'' in the article). They left here for Chicago where they will spend a few days on a visit to relatives and friends and from there go to New York City from where they will sail November 1st on the new American Hamburg line's steamer, the Imperator, for Hamburg. From there they will go by rail to Blokhus, via Aabybro, Denmark, where his aged father and six brothers and two sisters are still living. His mother died on the 24th of August this year. Just forty-four years ago Mr. Peterson left Denmark and came to this country. He sailed from Copenhagen on October 1st and landed in Quebec, Canada, two weeks later. From there he went direct to Chicago and then down on the Illinois Central to Effingham. From here he went to Gilmore and joined the Danish settlement at that place. Mr. Peterson is the last of that settlement in the Gilmore neighborhood. His father, in Denmark, has been captain of a lifesaving crew on the sea coast for many years, and also owned a large farm which he operated until his advanced age of ninety years prevented him from further active work. This will no doubt be the finest trip, back to his old home in the old country that Mr. Peterson has ever taken. He and his daughter, Mrs. Trapp, will remain there visiting relatives and friends until next April. This Record-Democrat will publish letters from them periodically. Of course the weekly Democrat will follow them over to Denmark to keep them posted on what's going on back home in the good old U.S. From handwritten notes made by Andrea (Siddens) Calhoun, granddaughter: Altamont couple Married 60 Years: Altamont, 1932-- Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Peterson celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary, October 13, at their home, with a reception and dinner for their relatives and friends. Eighty six were present. Mr. Peterson was born in Denmark in 1849, coming to America at the age of 21 years. Mrs. Peterson was born in Chicago in 1858. At the age of three, she came with her parents to the Gilmore vicinity. Mr. and Mrs. Peterson were married in Effingham, October 13, 1872. There is only one living witness to the marriage, Louis Assmuson, of Chicago. Mr. and Mrs. Peterson were the parents of 11 children, five of whom are living, namely John Peterson of Jackson township; Mrs. Dora Martin of Altamont; Mrs. Sophia Ohlson of Chicago; Henry at home; and Mrs. Lillian Siddens of Gilmore. Johnson, the last member of a family who helped shape the future of aeronautics and outboard navigation, died Thursday [calculated as October 7, 1976] at his residence in Lake Park, FL. A native of Effingham, IL, and formerly of Terre Haute, Johnson, had been acclaimed as a genius in the mechanical and aeronautical and engineering fields. His late brothers, Louis, Julius, and Harry Johnson, designed, constructed and flew the first singlewing concept aircraft, while Clarence was but a child. The ``monoplane'' in its first flight on August 8, 1911, flew a distance of 300 yards at an altitude of about 40 feet. The plane is now part of the collection at the Smithsonian Institution, Washington, DC. The younger Johnson followed his brothers in similar fields and with them was successful in developing the Johnson outboard motor, and later in founding the Johnson Outboard Motor Corporation. During his career Johnson became an accomplished pilot and flew exhibition flights at various state fairs. He held a commercial pilot's license. During World War 1, the U.S. Navy Department summoned Johnson to Washington, where he was given the task of developing control fins for torpedos. He was acclaimed as a pioneer and developer of many of the concepts used in contemporary aviation and navigation. His sister, Lutie, also precedes him in death. Surviving are the widow, Ruth Karnes Augustine Johnson, a son, Robert K. Johnson, and a granddaughter, Miss Linda Johnson, both of Roanoke, VA., and a stepson, Don Driver, of Racine, WI, Funeral services will be at 2:00 PM Monday at Peterson Funeral Home, 408 Sheridan Road, Waukegan, IL. Burial will follow in Northshore Garden of Memories. North Chicago. Effingham, Illinois Daily News (page 10, approximately October 13, 1976), Clarence was a pioneer in the development of the outboard motor. Clarence was an engineer and inventor and a founder of the Johnson Motor Corporation, now known as Outboard Marine Corporation in Waukegan. He and his brothers, Lou and Harry, started the company in 1921. The family lived in Effingham county until the family moved to Terre Haute, IN, where the brothers developed the first motors that led to the outboard. Clarence held a commercial pilot's license. He and his brothers developed the original concept of the single wing airplane on display in the Smithsonian Institute. During World War II, at the request of the U.S. Navy, Clarence also worked on development of control fins for torpedoes. The first model of Johnson outboard motor made, a 2 horsepower design, sold for \$140 in 1922 (as reported in an unknown newspaper article, along with a picture of Clarence, an outboard motor, and midwestern sales manager Tom Schaffer). Clarence became experimental engineer of Johnson Motors in Waukegan. Joseph G. Rayniak, president and manager of the corporation was production chief on founding of the firm by the three brothers.
